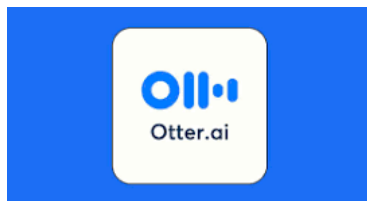


SpeechNotes

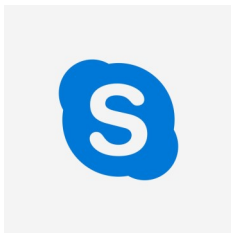

ASSISTIVE LISTENING APP

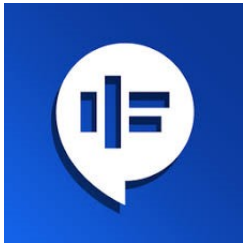

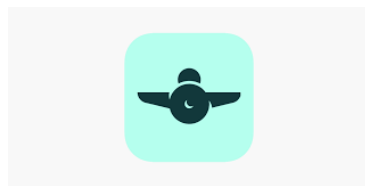
