

# PRE-EMPLOYMENT TRANSITION SERVICES

For Students with Disabilities



## What are Pre-Employment Transition Services?

Pre-ETS represent the earliest set of services available to students with disabilities who are eligible or potentially eligible for Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) services. Pre-ETS are generally short-term in nature and can be an important step in the transition to employment. Pre-ETS are designed to help students identify career interests, which may be further explored through additional vocational rehabilitation services, such as transition services and other individualized VR services.

#### What are the Five Pre-ETS?

- 1. Job Exploration Counseling
- 2. Work-Based Learning Experiences
- 3. Counseling on Post Secondary
- 4. Workplace Readiness
- 5. Instruction in Self Advocacy

#### Who is eligible to participate?

- 1. Must be aged 14-22; and
- 2. Eligible for and receiving services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), or is an individual with a disability for purposes of section 504.
- 3. Is enrolled in a secondary or postsecondary educational program

#### Who provides Pre-ETS services?

- VR counselors and Pre-ETS instructors: USOR's inhouse staff can provide Pre-ETS for students with disabilities.
- Pre-ETS contractors: The Utah State Office
  of Rehabilitation (USOR) has contracted with
  community partner agencies to provide Pre-ETS
  instruction for eligible and potentially eligible
  students, helping to ensure these services are
  available statewide.

**NOTE:** Receiving Pre-ETS instruction provided by a USOR-sponsored contract is the beginning of a continuum of services USOR offers to students with disabilities. Students with disabilities do not need to be a USOR-vocational rehabilitation client to receive Pre-ETS through our contracts, but may apply for VR services at any time. Contractors will confirm that students meet criteria to participate in their services prior to commencing with services.





#### 1. Job Exploration Counseling

Discussion or counseling of job exploring options intended to foster motivation, consideration of opportunities and informed decision-making.



#### 2. Work-Based Learning Experiences

An educational approach that uses the workplace or real work to provide students with the knowledge and skills that will help them connect school experiences to real-life work activities and future career opportunities. These opportunities are meant to engage, motivate and augment the learning process.



#### 3. Counseling on Post Secondary

Students gain an awareness of the wide range of career pathway options and labor market realities and projections. Students explore how skill development and knowledge relate to future opportunities in Postsecondary Education (PSE) settings and employment.



#### 4. Workplace Readiness

Workplace Readiness skills encompass the abilities that help employees learn how to interact with supervisors and co-workers. They help reinforce the importance of timeliness and build an understanding of how we are perceived by others.



#### 5. Instruction in Self Advocacy

Self-advocacy includes instruction regarding an individual's ability to effectively communicate, convey, negotiate or assert his/her own interests and/or desires. Emphasis is on taking responsibility for communicating one's needs and desires in a straightforward manner to others.


Pre-ETS Instructors provide Pre-ETS to eligible and potentially eligible students with disabilities.

They work with local school staff to provide Pre-ETS instruction in a school setting. Pre-ETS instructors meet with students in the classroom as well as individually and connect eligible students with work-based learning experiences when needed. They provide job readiness instruction in schools, in partnership with the teacher or school counselor. Pre-ETS Instructors may attend an IEP/504/other school meeting at a school if a VR counselor is unavailable.

VR Counselors provide support for eligible students with disabilities to ensure a smooth transition to independent adulthood. In addition, VR counselors can provide vocational counseling and guidance, vocational training, on-the-job training, employment supports, assistive technology, transition coordination, work adjustment training, IEP/504/other school meetings/events, and career exploration counseling. Since Pre-ETS offered through our contracts and Pre-ETS instructors are a "light touch" it is recommended that a student apply for VR and if eligible, work with a VR counselor if additional support is needed to transition to employment and independence. Note: An eligible student working with a VR counselor can still access services provided by the Pre-ETS contracts.


Which Pre-ETS Service Providers Are Best For Me?
