Employment: Beginning of Quarter Employment Total number of workers who were employed by the same employer in both the current and previous quarter. Note: Employment does not include Federal Government or Non-covered employers.

Net Job Flows: The difference between current and previous employment at each business.

Job Creation: The number of new jobs that are created by either new area businesses or the expansion of employment by existing firms.

Turnover: Turnover Rate = (1/2) * (full-quarter accessions + full-quarter separations) / employment stable jobs.
